INTRODUCTION: Geological Society of India has been organizing Indian National Earth Science Olympiad (INESO) and International Earth Science Olympiads (IESO) with entire support of Ministry of Earth Sciences (MoES) Govt of India for school students. Indian team of students has been participating in IESO since 2007. Seventh IESO at Mysuru in 2013 was hosted by India. The main purpose of the IESO is to create awareness about the origin of the universe, evolution of the life on Earth and to encourage students and public to take interest in Earth Sciences. One of IESO's competitions is 'International Team Field Investigation (ITFI)', wherein each team comprise of students from different countries that is absolutely in line with

Vasudhaiva Kutambakam - "The Earth is indeed a Family" to promote friendly relations among young students from different countries and international cooperation in the exchange of ideas for understanding the Earth System Process towards jointly resolving global challenges.

Four-stages of IESO: i. National Level Entrance Test (ET), ii. Training camp & INESO (selection of the four-member team after 3-week training programme), iii. Pre-departure Training Camp (1 week), iv. Participation in the IESO.

ENTRANCE TEST: An entrance test has been rescheduled on Saturday 27th January 2024 for 90 minutes at 10.30 am in English & comprise objective type of questions spanning Geology, Geophysics Meteorology, Oceanography, Terrestrial Astronomy and Environmental Science. For syllabus & limited reading materials, visit https://www.geosocindia.org/index.php/ieso Students should register online through the centre. The candidate should carry the school identity card and SHOULD NOT CARRY ANY MOBILE PHONE in examination hall on the day of the test. About Twenty-five students chosen in order of merit will attend a Virtual Training Camp.

TRAINING CAMP: The 3-week Training Camp will be held during May/June 2024 and will comprise lectures, discussions, data mining and poster presentation. The Indian National Earth Science Olympiad will be held at the end of the Camp. The top four students will be declared as winners of 17th INESO. The International Committee has decided to organise virtual IESO. The four winners of INESO will participate in the International Earth Science Olympiad to be held at Beijing, China.

The centre registration for the Entrance Test has been extended till 05th January 2024 and the Student registration has been extended till 10th January 2024, for details visit our website: https://www.geosocindia.org/index.php/ieso
